Scary Stats on Plastics

Before you open that plastic bottle of water or other beverage, take a look at what is happening!

- 1,000 people open a bottle of water every second of the day in the U.S.
- The average person uses 156 plastic bottles per year.
- A water bottle 25% full is the amount of oil it takes to produce the bottle.
- 60 million plastic water bottles are discarded every day in America.
- It can take 300 years for a plastic bottle to fragment, and it still never disappears.
- 91% of the world's plastic bottles are NOT recycled.
- 25 million TONS of plastic ends up in our oceans every year.
- By 2030 we will be pouring the equivalent of 2 garbage trucks of plastic into the ocean every minute, and 4 per minute if the planet reaches 2050.

We can do something to change this!

The main solution to water bottle pollution is to reduce our use of plastic. Here's how:

Use reusable water bottles. Make sure you recycle. Be an influencer and raise awareness by telling friends and family about the impact of plastic.
